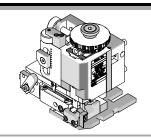

- Independent adjustment rings allow users to quickly adjust the conductor or insulation crimp height without affecting each other

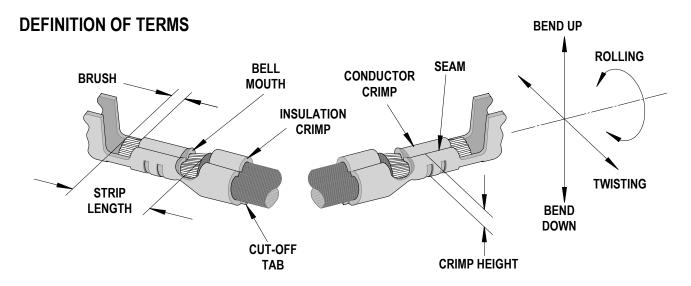

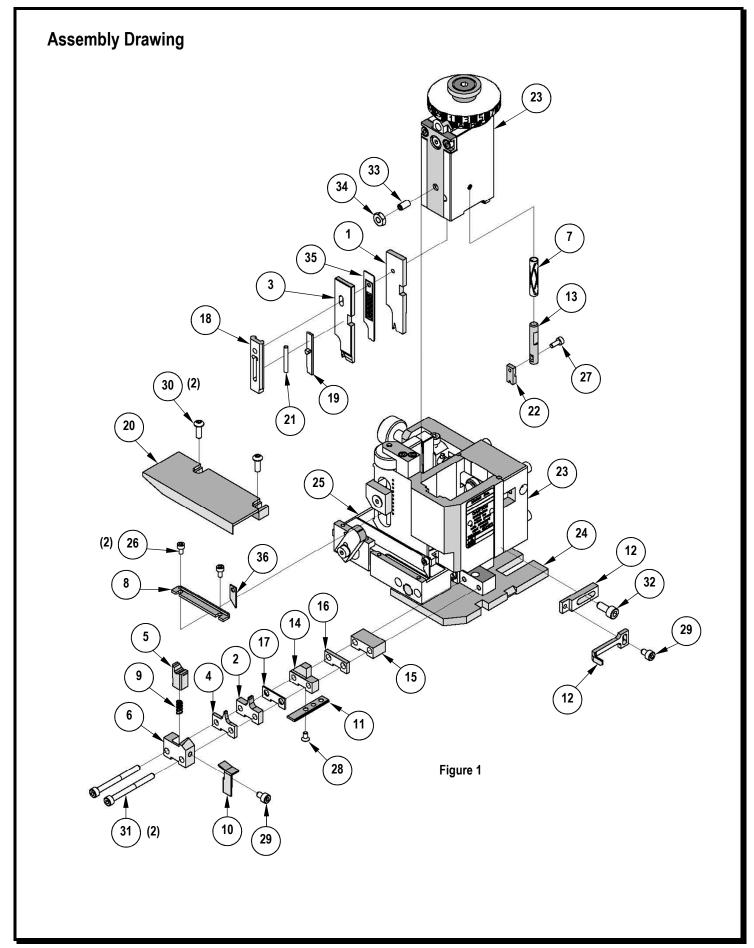

- 3. Slugs, terminals, dirt and oil should be kept clear of work area.

- 5. For recommended maintenance, refer to the FineAdjust™ manual.

**CAUTION:** This applicator should only be used in a press with a shut height of 135.80 mm (5.346"). Tooling damage could result at a lower setting.

**CAUTION:** To prevent injury, never operate this Applicator without the guards supplied with the press or wire-processing machine in place. Reference the press or wire processing manufacturer's instruction manual.

CAUTION: Molex crimp specifications are valid only when used with Molex terminals, applicators and tooling.
